

## **SUMMER CAMP EQUIPMENT LIST**

### **REQUIRED ITEMS**

- Complete Class "A" Scout Uniform, labeled with Scout's name and troop # 250**  
(BSA hat, 250 neckerchief, khaki BSA shirt with current rank and patrol patches, green BSA belt, green BSA shorts and/or blue jeans, BSA green socks)
- tennis shoes in good condition (or normal summer shoes used all day for walking, not sandals)
- two Troop 250 gray T-shirts, labeled
- one Troop 250 sweatshirt, labeled
- six pairs of underwear
- six pairs of white socks
- one or two swimming suits
- two towels for use after swimming and bathing
- two extra shirts: light, 1-short sleeve & 1-long sleeve
- one extra pair of shorts
- one extra pair of long pants
- one mess kit with unique ID on each piece (plate, cup, spoon, knife, fork, bowl)
- one sleeping bag or bedding
- one toiletries kit (soap, washcloth, shampoo, toothbrush/paste, deodorant, comb, hand towel)
- one heavy sweatshirt or sweater
- one warm jacket
- one canteen
- notebook & pencils
- scout handbook
- merit badge books ( donate to Troop after class if you do not want them)
- flashlight with extra batteries
- rain gear (if needed, it will get worn hard)
- spending money (merit badge supplies, some snacks and sodas, maybe a T-shirt, ect.)
- insect repellent (non-aerosol: creams are best (face & skin), pumps are second best (clothing))
- prescription medicine of any type (must be turned in to Scoutmaster)
- sleep wear
- one backpack or large duffel (everything must fit in it)
- one bike helmet along with your bike
- mosquito bar ( a real life-saver -this netting goes over your cot & keeps some of the pesky critters away)

### **NICE TO HAVE ITEMS**

- non-road bike with a helmet and a lock ( must have bike helmet to ride at Tapico)
- day or belt pack (a must if you have a bike)
- watch
- suntan lotion (a must if you have water-front merit badges, waterproof kind)

### **NICE TO HAVE ITEMS, cont.**

- compass
- lock-blade pocket size knife (not longer than the width of the palm of the user's hand, max. 3 inches)
  - Toten' Chip Card to use knife
- pillow
- postcards or envelopes with stamps (pre-addressed)

### **EXTRA ITEMS**

- fishing gear (do not bring live bait)
- strip of carpet ( to give your tent a floor)
- hiking shoes for hiking, water-proof boots/shoes or extra shoes in case of rain
- camera (and film)
- Bible or prayer book
- name plate for tent
- hand mirror
- sewing kit
- small amount of snacks (do not store in tent & have enough to share)
- extra pair swim trunks (they don't always dry before you have to put them on again)
- musical instrument ( or other ways to entertain a crowd)
- bike parts and repair kit (troop will also bring one)

### **NO-NO ITEMS**

- fireworks
- battery operated amusement items (radio, TV, games, keyboards, CDplayers)
- non-prescription medicine, i.e. aspirin, Pepto-Bismol
- bandaids, ect.

### **ADULT ONLY ITEMS**

- board for support of bed springs
- table, chair or ect. ( a chair is really nice in tent or for around camp site)
- soda & cooler ( Tapico is not responsible for providing ice, but we usually get some)
- large amounts of snacks (cookies, marshmallows, smores, T-bone steaks...)
